Dear

Enclosed you will find the *Rule of the Dominican Third Order* as well as a few other documents about the Dominican life<sup>1</sup>. You will also be receiving a regularly published newsletter.

As with religious, there is a time of postulancy and a time of novitiate before making profession. This is important to be remembered when you read these texts; the postulancy and novitiate provide the time to study and put into practice the Constitutions little by little. It is not a matter of doing everything perfectly all at once from the beginning. You have, as it were, a time of apprenticeship. Down through the centuries thousands of Dominican tertiaries have been sanctified by practising the Rule; today, like yesterday, with the grace of Our Lord Jesus Christ it is possible to do the same by following the Constitutions which have been adapted to our times, and which permit legitimate dispensations in certain cases.

Generally speaking, the course of procedure is the following:

-Upon reception of this letter you will start to get a better idea of what the Third Order entails. Read the information and try to put into practice some of the obligations of the Rule. Send us any and all questions you may have, and let us know how things are going. If after a certain time of reflection and prayer, you desire to become a postulant, fill out the application form and send it to us *along with a letter of recommendation from a priest*.

-Once we receive your request to enter the Order, you become officially a "Postulant". During the time of postulancy, you will continue to learn more about the Order, and progressively put into practice the obligations of the Constitutions. At least every three months or so, it will be necessary to inform us by letter (or e-mail) of your progress and difficulties, so that we (and you) may be able to make an informed decision about your vocation in the Order, and so that we may look into the possibility of granting dispensations if necessary. After a year or so of postulancy, if there are no obstacles, you become eligible to be received among the Novices. (However, a further time of reflection is also possible.)

-The reception into the novitiate consists in a ceremony where you receive the habit and your religious name. If we are not able to come, this ceremony may be performed by a priest to whom we have delegated the power to do so. The time of novitiate is variable, and terminates when the Novice makes profession in the Order.

More complete information will be given as it is needed. Again, you may write to us with any questions. Unfortunately, the large distance prevents us from visiting our tertiaries as much as we would like, but we will keep you informed of any voyages that may give us the possibility to meet up with you. We can also put you in contact with other tertiaries living in your area, as the case may be.
