Intrinsic Analogy: when the concept itself is of a proportion it is essentially analogous

Extrinsic Analogy: when the concept itself is not of a proportion but Is PLACED in a proportion, it is not essentially analogous

Metaphor: when the concept does not properly apply to something But is extended to it because of some accidental likeness or resemblance

Attribution: when the concept does not properly apply to something But is extended to it because of some causal relationship
