It has been voiced by various foundations and organizations, such as the American Eugenics Society, the National Council on Eugenics, and the International Eugenics Federation. These groups have conducted research and advocacy work to promote eugenics policies, including sterilization laws, immigration restrictions, and other measures to control population growth and improve the quality of the human race. The term "eugenics" is derived from the Greek words "eu" (good) and "genos" (race). It was first coined by Francis Galton in 1883.
